- Meeting minutes from October meeting reviewed and approved

- President/Vice President review-
 - Meetings were held during the past month with board members concerning the ongoing review of a referee incident during the fall season. Doug is currently pursuing more information directly from the player/parent involved. Will then meet again to decide as a board what the next step is

- Admin-

- Tournament-
